1. Overview

This is a pointer to Deliverable 7.3 of Work Package 7. The Deliverable Title is:

Project Web Site and Wiki

The Work Package Title is:

Dissemination

It runs from month 1 (January 2011) until the end of the project (December 2012).

Deliverable 7.3 is summarised in the work plan as follows:

There will be a web site and wiki.

There will be a consultation period at project start to recheck the bid assumptions (software enhancements and other factors may affect them) but it is likely that the wiki software used will be MediaWiki with the Semantic Web toolkit - to allow compatibility, interoperability, ease of reporting, and cross-linking to/from Wikipedia education-related pages, WikiEducator and the Re.ViCa wiki. A pilot site was set up at <http://e-learning.referata.com> for tests.

The Project Wiki is inherited from the Re.ViCa project (<http://visced.referata.com>) but renamed <http://www.virtualschoolsandcolleges.eu> - thus the software used is MediaWiki. The software was updated in late 2011 to the latest MediaWiki release but at present there is no clear justification within the VISCED project for enhancing it further with Semantic Wiki features. (This discussion will take place in 2012 within the POERUP project.)

The Wiki is updated almost daily including at weekends.

The Web Site is updated frequently.
